



Cold Fire is an environmentally safe fire extinguishing agent, specifically designed to rapidly suppress and extinguish fires, cool hot surfaces, prevent reignition, and encapsulate hydrocarbons. Cold Fire contains no PFAS, is safe to store, handle, and use, leaves virtually no residue, is biodegradable, and is neither toxic nor corrosive.

SECTION 3: COMPOSITION INFORMATION

Patented formula and components classified as trade secrets. Its composition is environmentally friendly, consisting of water, biodegradable anionic and non-ionic surfactants, organic and mineral compounds that have been tested free of PFAS (perfluoroalkyl and polyfluoroalkyl substances). Cold Fire is transparent with a clean and fresh scent.

SECTION 4: FIRST AID MEASURES

After skin contact: Wash the skin with water.

After eye contact: Rinse eyes with water.

After inhalation: Not hazardous.

After ingestion: Do not ingest. Not considered toxic via oral exposure.

SECTION 5: FIRE-FIGHTING MEASURES

Non-flammable: Contains no hazardous combustion components. Water-based product; will not self-ignite.

SECTION 6: ACCIDENTAL RELEASE MEASURES

In case of spill: Wash the affected area with water and allow it to dry.

Environmental disposal measures: Dispose of as non-hazardous waste in accordance with local regulations. PFAS-free.

SECTION 7: HANDLING AND STORAGE

Handling: Respiratory protection, not required.

Ventilation: Under normal conditions for its intended use, no special ventilation is required.

Protective gloves: Use if prolonged skin contact occurs, as natural surfactants may dry the skin.

Eye protection: Use if necessary to prevent potential eye contact.

Storage: Store at temperatures between 0°C and 49°C in sealed containers to prevent evaporation and/or degradation.

Shelf life: Cold Fire has an indefinite shelf life when stored in closed containers within a controlled temperature environment.

General protection and hygiene measures: Wash hands before and after handling as a hygiene precaution. No special protective equipment is required.

SECTION 11: TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION

Toxicity: According to the U.S. EPA Office of Pollution Prevention and Toxics criteria for classifying the acute toxicity of chemicals in the aquatic environment, Cold Fire is considered low hazard.

-96-hour acute toxicity to freshwater algae (selenastrum capricornutum) IAW 40 CFR 797.1050: showed Cold Fire to be algacidal at concentrations above 750 ppm.
-96-hour acute toxicity to juvenile rainbow trout (oncorhynchus mykiss) IAW 49 CFR 797.1400: showed an LC of 105 ppm.

Biodegradability: The product is 100% biodegradable in an active environment within 21 days.

The product is PFAS-free.
